

Design a Church

Shapes Activity



heritage learning welcome

This activity will allow the children to use their knowledge of what a church building is like to design their own outside of a church building.

KS1/KS2

You will need:

1. Sheet of A4 or A3 paper per pair or small group.
2. 2 or 3 copies of the shapes sheet per pair/small group.
3. Scissors, glue sticks and pencils.

Tell the children that they have the opportunity to design their own church building from the outside. What are the key features they will need? They will need to draw on their understanding from the church architecture for this.

Encourage them to consider whether the building will be old or modern, tall or short, what will the windows be like?

Once the children have finished they could label or write a paragraph to explain their choices for their church building.
